“In crafting the score I used a variety of both orchestral and exotic instruments. Vigorous strings, proud brass, and whimsical woodwinds formed the orchestral backbone of the music. As the world of Chima is very lush and full of life I also incorporated exotic wind instruments, colorful ethnic percussion, and rich synthesizer textures to further develop the sound palette. The opportunity to compose and develop melodic motifs to represent the growth of the Chima kingdom was also a key component of the music score. All in all I had a great time composing for this wonderful franchise and video game.”
